Ali's comments:

3491. The goodly homes mentioned in <u>16:41</u> referred to this life, but it was stated there that the reward of the Hereafter would be greater.

Here the simile of the Home is referred to Heaven:

- -it will be beautiful;
- -it will be picturesque, with the sight and sound of softly-murmuring streams;
- -it will be lofty or sublime; and
- -it will be eternal.
